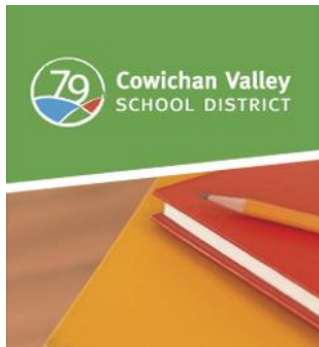




School District 79- Cowichan Valley

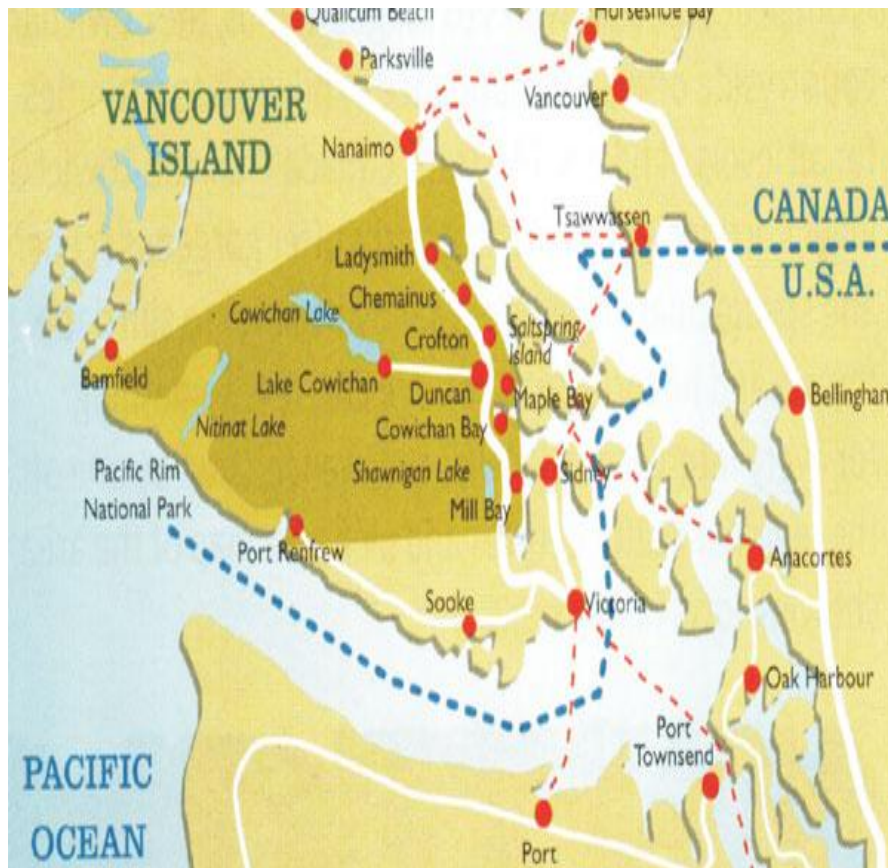
